It was a great pleasure meeting you last week in Reno. We were so pleased by your engagement and enthusiasm. We are preparing a communication for your Chiefs to thank them for your participation in the program and to let them know about the next steps.

As we discussed during the next steps session, there are a set of next steps for this program. On September 12 - 14, we will be convening for our second in-person seminar in Woods Hole, Massachusetts for three days consolidating our leadership learning but delving more deeply into climate science and specific climate science topics.
