I am in receipt of the request for public information under Arkansas Supreme Court Administrative Order Number 19 from The Patriots Foundation. Pursuant to the request, I am happy to provide the enclosed documents to you on its behalf relating to the 2024 Judicial Leaders in Climate Science program put on by the National Judicial College in conjunction with the Environmental Law Institute and the Climate Judicial Project.

The Judiciary is neither a scientific community nor a branch of government that sets or influences climate policy. I therefore declined to create or give a presentation relating to the materials presented in the JLCS program. Giving a presentation about a scientific viewpoint which might become the subject of litigation would, in my opinion, be potentially disqualifying.

At the conclusion of the program, I maintained no materials and only recent correspondence. I have enclosed the correspondence I received over the past year responsive to your request (JBRO 001 – 004). There are no replies enclosed here because I did not reply to them. I could locate no other responsive documents from any period of time.
