Good morning Lynn and Clare.

It is my pleasure to introduce Judge Lynn Knight of Maryland to Judge Clare Keithley of California. Lynn was a very engaged member of the first cohort of the Judicial Leaders in Climate Science (JLCS) and she has graciously agreed to serve as your mentor, Clare, as you move forward as a truly thoughtful member of the second cohort. Lynn brought a pragmatic wisdom to each conversation and has been successful in developing an

educational program with the Maryland Judicial College, a lunchtime webinar, and will host a full day training session this fall. She has truly put the JLCS training into practice!
