Dear CJP Curriculum Advisory Committee,

We are looking forward to seeing many of you at our Advisory Committee meeting this

Friday, June 6 from 12 to 1:30 pm Eastern. Please use this [Zoom link](#) for the meeting (which I will also include in the calendar invitation that you should already have). If you have not yet RSVP'd, it would be great if you could let us know if you can make it.

Given the moment we are in for both environmental law and climate science – really, the rule of law and the American scientific endeavor more broadly – we would like to use the bulk of our time together to get your impressions where we are, what is ahead, and what is needed in this moment.

We will also update you on some of the Project's highlights from the past year as well as on our plans going forward. Here is an overview of how we hope to spend our time together:

In an effort to keep the updates portion of the meeting brief and have more time to hear from you, I am providing several items here.

First, with respect to the curriculum updates, we have recently published two new modules in our *Climate Science and Law for Judges* curriculum (one on [Sea Level Rise](#) and one on [Climate Litigation in Europe](#)), as well as a [Supplemental Paper on Attribution](#). We are also moving forward apace on our new curriculum focused on the energy transition. To that end, we have assembled a new advisory committee focused on this topic (list of members attached) who have helped us craft an outline for the new 12-module curriculum (also attached).

Second, with respect to the narratives around CJP, we wanted to share [this Guardian piece](#) about the Project as well as the attached article I published in the *Practical Real Estate Lawyer* which sets forth our understanding of the breadth of climate litigation.
