Aloha Loretta,

Thanks for your assistance on Julia's hotel expenses.

I can understand and appreciate your questions about her different hotel.

I have been providing updates to Scott on our entire budget earlier and I'm happy to provide you the hotel budget update now.

See the table below on the hotel expenses and how we have allocated ELI's funding so far.

Thus far, we have committed a total of \$10,890 for hotel, including Julia (and David King, whose hotel is not yet confirmed, but will also likely not be the Holiday Inn for

various reasons). There is only one federal judge whose hotel needs I do not yet know - so that would be the last one supported by the ELI budget. The others listed below (about 28 nights total) are paid from other sources.

We have offered to pay rooms for a few high-level speakers who are not judges, including Ms. Olson, who is the lead counsel for the Our Children's Trust lawsuit as well an invited speaker at the Conference of Chief Justices to follow our Symposium.

Since she is already staying at the Sheraton for the CCJ (which they are paying for), she does not want to change hotels, which is understandable and we have therefore offered to cover her lodging at the same rate we are paying at the Holiday Inn (we are not paying the Sheraton rate, which is much higher). (CCJ is also paying for her flights, another benefit to us, which is true with several other CCJ-invited speakers).

How would you like to proceed? Do you need an invoice from Brittany, her assistant?

Please let us know how we can assist you to make this as easy as possible from your end.
