I have a question ... I am currently in Tokyo, returning to DC tomorrow (Tuesday). I am planning to work from home and self-monitor (per CDC guidance). This seems a little odd, as the U.S. now has more COVID19 cases, but I figure some caution doesn't hurt. Do you know if there are any limitations on people entering Brazil (I have not traveled to the hotspots -- China, South Korea, Italy, Iran, etc.), but Japan is high enough that I wanted to inquire if you have any knowledge.

On another note, ELI just launched a 3-year program to train judges in Colombia on cases related to deforestation in four Amazonian departments. I was in Bogota and Villavicencio 10 days to launch the project and start consultations. I have included some modest funding to involve you and the GJIE. I am hoping we can find some time to discuss it further in Rio.
