Good morning all,

Thank you all for taking some time to meet with me regarding the climate science program. It was nice to see everyone again! I'm reaching out to reiterate a few important points and dates discussed during yesterday's meeting.

- The webinar for this program is scheduled for **Wednesday, May 17, 2023 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.** I'm currently working with our education design coordinator to create an eblast to advertise this event and get as many judges as possible registered for the webinar. John, thank you for providing a brief program description. I'll use language from your description in the eblast advertisement. I'll also include information about the featured presenters to boost enrollment. I'll provide you all with a draft copy of the advertisement on or before **Wednesday, February 22, 2023**. Once I receive and incorporate your feedback, I'll forward the eblast to our registrar for distribution to the judges.
- Our next check in meeting is scheduled for **Friday, March 10, 2023 at 10:30 a.m.** In addition to any content-specific matters you all would like to discuss, I'd love to review enrollment numbers for the webinar and determine next steps for planning the full day program. We'll also set a date to meet with all confirmed presenters for the webinar. Between now and March 10th, I'll speak with Judge Shannon Avery, Judge Mary Kent, and Judge Brian Shockley (Judge Knight and Sandra, I'll periodically follow up with you all on these conversations). Each of these judges are currently presiding over cases involving climate science. I'll poll them to create a list of topics that would be of particular interest to Maryland's sitting judges for part 4 of the webinar. I'll bring these findings to the group in our March 10th meeting.
- I'll follow up shortly with calendar invites and Zoom links for the aforementioned dates. If there's something I missed, *please* don't hesitate to reach out. All feedback on the planning process is welcome and appreciated.
